## What is Human Trafficking?

The American Nurses Association identifies human trafficking as a health issue. "Human trafficking is an often hidden example of violating human rights. It occurs when vulnerable persons are exploited in sex industries or labor markets."

## Warning Signs and Indicators

- Victims can be anyone
- Physical signs: bruises, cuts, weight loss, etc.
- Non-physical signs: fear, nervousness, malnourishment, lack of sleep, anxiety, etc
- Fear of being touched
- Apprehensive to talk to you
- Environment: Overcrowded, unsanitary, unsafe conditions

Illinois is ranked 11th regarding human trafficking in the U.S.

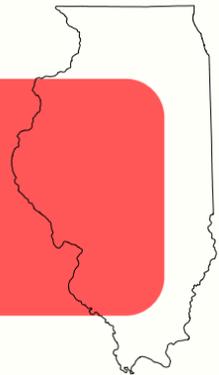
